Making the Move From Diapers

Making a clear switch out of diapers sends your child the signal that he or she is becoming a Big Kid® and is ready to use the potty.

Making the Move From Diapers

- ★ Be consistent. Going back and forth between diapers and training pants, even at night, sends a confusing message and may actually slow the process.
- ★ Build excitement by showing your child how training pants look just like Big Kid® underwear.
- ★ Practice with the new pants. Before making the switch, have your child practice pulling them on and off so they are prepared when it is time to go.
- ★ Do a trial run. Try giving your toddler the chance to sit on the potty, with pants both on and with them off, to help them get used to the new routine.
- ★ Celebrate each success. Make a big deal out of the first time your child uses his or her training pants correctly.
